How to Be Considered for a Grant

Submit a grant application via the STAR system. If access to the STAR system is needed please contact ECFPortland@boeing.com.

Organization Eligibility

Did not receive a grant from the Portland Chapter of ECF in the previous year Only Health and Human Services organizations in good financial standing with an Internal Revenue Service designation as a 501(c)3 charitable organization for a minimum of the previous two years will be eligible to apply for a grant Certain types of organizations will be ineligible to apply for grants including:

Organizations that denigrate or advocate discrimination or violence toward any racial, ethnic or cultural group

Political organizations

Fraternal, sectarian, social, religious (see exception in the ECF Focus Areas section), or similar organizations
